SCHOOL DIVISIONS

CHILDRENS DIVISION (AGES 2-7)

- Dance with Me, Joy of Dance, Creative Movement, Pre-Ballet I, Pre-Ballet II, Pre-Ballet III
- Classes meet once per week
- Dance with Me, Joy of Dance, Creative Movement, & Pre-Ballet I are 45 minutes
- Pre-Ballet II & Pre-Ballet III classes are 1 hour
- Pre-Ballet III has the option to meet twice a week

COMMUNITY YOUTH DIVISION (AGES 8-18)

- Beginner Ballet, Intermediate Ballet, Advanced Ballet
- Classes meet one to 4 times per week, dependent on level
- All technique classes are an hour and a half
- Advanced dancers must be invited by teacher to take pointe

ACADEMY DIVISION (AGES 8-18)

- Levels 1-6
- Audition Required
- Classes meet up to 6 days a week depending on level
- Students in the Academy can expect vigorous training to propel them into a higher education or career in dance
- Academy students are required to take all the classes in their current level offerings
- Academy students have the option to "add on" additional Optional Disciplines as long as it does not interfere with their level requirements

YOUNG MEN'S SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

- Audition Required
- Guaranteed 1 year of tuition-free training followed by merit-based scholarships
- Young Men's class meets 1-2 times per week depending on level
- Students are required to participate in all School of Nashville Ballet shows
- Offers specialized training for young men, tailored to their unique needs and taught by men

PRE-PROFESSIONAL DIVISION

- Morning Program, Early Release Program
- Audition Required
- Classes meet six days per week either 9am-2pm or 2pm-6pm
- Our newly structured Pre-Professional Division is designed to accommodate the unique needs of dedicated dancers seeking a high-caliber ballet education alongside their academic pursuits

PROFESSIONAL DIVISION

- Audition Required
- Students meet Monday through Friday from 9:00-4:30 pm
- The Professional Division (PD) is a comprehensive program for preprofessional dancers, designed to further develop technique, strength, and artistry in a rigorous environment. Dancers selected for this program are chosen for their talent and potential to pursue a career in professional dance

CHILDREN'S DIVISION

Enrollment is determined by age. Children should meet age requirements listed with each fall class offering by August 12 and each spring class offering by January 6. All classes for ages 2-8 meet once per week. It is recommended children take two semesters of each class prior to moving up. If you have any questions regarding your child's placement, please email school@nashvilleballet.com and we will forward your message to their instructor! There is an optional Spring Children's Recital that each dancer is welcome to participate in with a \$100 recital fee.

DANCE WITH ME (AGES 2+)

Dance With Me builds coordination and rhythm while introducing children to movement, music, and creative play. With the support of a parent, grandparent or caregiver, young dancers can experience peer-to-peer interaction and exciting, imaginary adventures. The goal in this class is to encourage participation and build confidence so the child feels comfortable coming to class on their own in the future.

COMMUNITY YOUTH DIVISION

Our Community Division Youth Classes introduce dancers to the fundamentals of classical ballet education using the foundation of the School of Nashville Ballet syllabus. Students enrolled in Community Division Youth Classes receive high-caliber training from School of Nashville Ballet faculty in an environment that establishes a foundation for dance education and continued technical development. Youth classes are open to ages 8 to 18, offering Beginner, Intermediate, and Advanced placements. Each student will be placed in the level that best reflects their current level of training and ability per a placement class. There is an optional Spring Community Youth Recital that each dancer is welcome to participate in with a \$100 recital fee.

TUITION

ACADEMY DIVISION (AGES 8-18)

School of Nashville Ballet faculty members carefully nurture each Academy student's technical execution, artistic expression, and maturity. Through careful development and attention to the syllabus, our instructors implement a curriculum that is designed to produce dancers with both expressiveness and clear classical lines. This guidance enables students to develop their own artistry, while pure classical technique provides the vehicle for their artistic expression. Each schedule has a list of suggested Optional Disciplines to take in addition to the minimum Academy classes, but your dancer is welcome to take whichever level of Optional Discipline that is most appropriate for them. Each dancer has the option to participate in a showcase which will have a \$275 fee.

Payment Policy (Children's/Community Youth/Optional Disciplines)

I understand that I am enrolling my child into a non-refundable annual membership for the term dated August 12, 2024, through May 10, 2025. I understand that I am required to submit in writing a 30-Day cancellation notice to stop recurring monthly auto-drafts. I agree to pay all fees due by the 15th of every month or I will incur a \$10 late fee. I understand that all services and fees incurred by my child while enrolled at the School of Nashville Ballet are non-refundable, these fees include but are not limited to: annual tuition, merchandise, private lessons, costume fees, performance fees, studio rental fees, winter intensives, summer intensives, events, and other activities throughout August 12, 2024, through May 10, 2025 school year.

Monthly dues are calculated over the entire school year of classes held over 10 months August-May. I understand that I am not paying for scheduled school vacations or holidays.

The Registration Fee is due upon enrollment. All other months are due by the 15h of each calendar month. Any student with an overdue balance of more than 45 days will not be allowed into class until payment in full is received. Overdue balances must be paid by cash or card.

Discounts: A 10% sibling discount is offered for the second sibling.

Annual Payment Terms Full Annual Pay & Credit Card/Debit Card Charge Authorization: School of Nashville Ballet offers customers the opportunity to purchase the full payment option in one annual payment, due at the time of registration. School of Nashville Ballet accepts credit card/debit card payments to permit customers to pay for these in full. This contract is a full year (10 Months).

<u>Full Payment Due Upon Checkout:</u> I acknowledge and agree to pay for the annual class dues at School of Nashville Ballet for the total amount sessions designated by registration. I hereby authorize School of Nashville Ballet to charge the credit card/debit card on file to pay this full payment.

Monthly Payment Terms – Auto Pay & Credit Card/Debit Card Charge Authorization: School of Nashville Ballet offers customers the opportunity to make montly payment installments for certain tuition purchases. School of Nashville Ballet accepts credit card/debit card payments to permit customers to pay for these classes. *This contract is a full-year contract. (10 months)* A 30-day handwritten notice of withdrawal is required to discontinue any classes and charges. **You will have 1 more billing cycle that will occur once the notice is received**. If you decide to re-enroll, you will have to re-register (100.00 registration fee).

Payment of Monthly Dues: I acknowledge and agree to pay for classes at School of Nashville Ballet and do promise to pay School of Nashville Ballet for the enrolled total for the contracted classes. I hereby authorize School of Nashville Ballet to charge the credit card/debit card on file every 30 days in order to pay these installments. All students enrolled in classes are required to have a credit card on file. Tuition will be AUTO DRAFTED on the 15th of each month using the card provided at registration you choose for Auto-Pay. Should a parent wish to use another method for payment, they are welcome to do so but payment MUST BE MADE before the 15th of the month to avoid the auto draft. (NO EXCEPTIONS). School of Nashville Ballet monthly tuition is based on a four-week month. No additional charge is assessed for months that offer five classes. In the months when holidays affect the schedule of classes, no tuition is reduced. Checks should be made payable to School of Nashville Ballet with the driver's license number written on the check. The check should also include the name of the student. A \$30 fee (and any additional court costs if necessary) will be assessed on all returned checks. Tuition is not pro-rated for absences. Please review the Make-up policies below.

<u>Late Fee:</u> A late fee of \$10 will be applied on the 16th of the month if payment has not been submitted. If you choose not to use automatic payment, tuition can by paid by cash, Visa, MasterCard, Debit Card or check, payable to School of Nashville Ballet before the 15th of the month. All tuition payments are due on or before the 15th day of each month. School of Nashville Ballet will only send billing statements to delinquent account holders, notifying them of non-payment and late fee service charges. Students of delinquent account holders will not be permitted in class until accounts are brought up to date.

Return Charges: I acknowledge and agree that a fee of \$30.00 will be charged for any returned check or credit card/debit card charge not honored by the bank for any reason when processing any credit card/debit card charge. I agree to notify School of Nashville Ballet no less than thirty (30) days in advance of any change to my credit card/debit card account to prevent this \$30.00 fee from being charged.

No Transfer: I acknowledge that this agreement is non-transferable.

<u>Cancellation Policy:</u> To cancel enrollment, a cancellation form is required to be completed and returned to the studio at least thirty (30) days prior to the next scheduled withdrawal date, otherwise, the next scheduled withdrawal may still be processed. You will have thirty (30) days to use any and all sessions accrued on your account. If you choose to re-enroll in the future, you will have to re-register (\$100.00 registration fee).

<u>Non-Payment:</u> If there is an outstanding non-payment balance. School of Nashville Ballet must resort to retaining an attorney or collection agency to enforce payment under this agreement. Legal action will be taken for all accounts 60 days past due. Court costs are the responsibility of the billing contact.

Non-Refundable Tuition and Other Fees: It is the policy of School of Nashville Ballet that all tuition, registration, performance, and other fees paid shall not be refunded at any time, regardless of the time of cancellation by the student or student's parents or guardians or whether the relevant program has commenced. If the relevant program has been canceled by the School of Nashville Ballet, we will make our best efforts to move the student into a substantially similar program; if no such substantially similar program exists, the School will issue a full refund.

Attendance & Make-Up Classes: Students should arrive promptly for their scheduled class. Good attendance is imperative for proper training. Excessive absences and tardiness can hamper the progress of the entire class. If a student will be missing class, please fill out an absence form online which can be found under the appropriate division. It is the student's responsibility to make up the missed class and learn the missed material. Make-up classes are not permitted during observation week. If you are injured or sick for more than 2 days, you must present a note from a doctor to the program director. Without a doctor's note, you will not be allowed in class until the School receives one. If you miss more than 4 unexcused classes within a semester, because of an injury or illness, certain measures will be taken with the School. Children arriving more than 15 minutes late may not be admitted to their class, at the discretion of the instructor. Make-up classes are allowed and encouraged if the student misses a class. Make-up classes must be taken within one month of the missed class. The make-up class must be a same-level class or one level below. Please fill out the make-up class clipboard when checking in at the front desk that day.
